## How to Apply for Rebates

1. Complete rebate application for each installation address. Electronic rebate forms can be found at [SummitUtilities.com/ARFoodservice](https://www.summitutilities.com/ARFoodservice)
2. Rebate applications must include a dated copy of the paid, itemized invoice(s). Invoices must include brand, complete model number, purchaser's name and installation address.
3. Rebate applications must include a current copy of the customer's W9.
4. If you have questions, please contact your Summit Utilities account manager or one of our energy efficiency experts to discuss and/or complete the rebate application form.
5. Keep a copy of this document for your records.

7. Rebate payments are made six to eight weeks after the rebate application has been processed. Rebate checks will be issued to the name listed on the Summit Utilities account.

## Rules and Requirements

- Rebates apply to new equipment only. Warranty replacement equipment is not eligible for a rebate.
- Equipment that switches fuel from electric to natural gas is not eligible.
- Equipment must meet program specification requirements and be purchased, installed and operating prior to submitting a rebate application. For qualified equipment lists, and rebates listed with CEW or ENERGY STAR® ratings, refer to our website [SummitUtilities.com/ARFoodservice](https://www.summitutilities.com/ARFoodservice).
- Summit Utilities reserves the right to limit any rebate and conduct on-site inspections of installed equipment.
- A completed application must include proof of purchase and current W9.
- Summit Utilities is not responsible for incorrect or incomplete applications, or for applications that are not submitted in a timely manner.
- Rebate qualifications and amounts are subject to change. Summit Utilities Conservation Improvement Programs (CIP) rebate programs may be cancelled or changed at any time.
- Program Dates: Jan. 1 - Dec. 31
- Rebate applications must be received by Dec. 31 of the year equipment is installed.
